

RESOLUTION 2017-02

To amend Section 4 of the Bylaws of the Milledgeville Amateur Radio Club to clarify membership categories and to allow for a student member classification.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MILLEDGEVILLE AMATEUR RADIO CLUB:

SECTION 1.

Section 4 of the Bylaws of the Milledgeville Amateur Radio Club be amended as follows:

**Section 4: Dues**

~~Dues of \$20.00 per annum shall be due at the January club meeting. Dues shall be paid at or before the beginning of the January meeting in order to retain membership and be eligible to vote on club business. Any applications for new membership at the January meeting will be voted on prior to the election of officers so that new members will have the opportunity to participate in the election. If a club member from the previous year has not paid dues by April 1st, he/she must reapply for club membership. If two or more licensed amateur radio operators are related and live in the same dwelling and desire to become club members; only one individual will pay the \$20.00 annual dues fee with each additional individual paying \$5.00. Individual youth (age 18 or younger) shall pay an annual membership fee of \$10.00.~~

- A. Dues must be paid by the January meeting in order to retain membership and be eligible to vote on club business. Any applications for new membership at the

January meeting will be voted on prior to the election of officers so that new members will have the opportunity to participate in the election.

B. If a club member from the previous year has not paid dues by April 1st, the individual must reapply for club membership.

C. Membership Types

- a. Individual Membership available to persons meeting the qualifications of Section 2 of these bylaws. Dues for these members shall be twenty dollars (\$20.00) per year.
- b. Family Membership shall be available to individuals who live in the same dwelling as an individual member. Dues for these members are five dollars (\$5.00) per year.
- c. Youth Membership shall be available to individuals who are aged eighteen (18) years or younger. Dues for these members are ten dollars (\$10.00) per year.
- d. Student Membership shall be available to degree seeking students enrolled at least half-time (as based on the institution's requirements) at an institution of higher learning accredited by a regional accreditation agency recognized by the US Department of Education. Dues for these members are ten dollars (\$10.00) per year.
